1	In the case study it is mentioned that the pickup location is from UK and the final destination is OWO state in Nigeria. We wish to clarify, who will be the shipper in this case , who will be the consignee and will the shipper be eligible for exporting , and registered with UK customs , similarly the will the consignee be registered with Nigerian Customs for imports?	For the purposes of this case study, bidders should assume that GOAL and partners have the required licenses to export the items from the UK. The consignee in this case study is the Nigerian Government Centre for Disease Control and therefore can be assumed to also be registered for import.
2	Also need clarification on item number 35, are they human samples?	For the purposes of this case study, please make the assumption that at least some of the samples will be of human origin.
